Through this partnership, we are expanding community awareness of these entities' cultural events and offerings and building a cultural center in downtown Greenwood.


Opportunities abound through the joint efforts of these entities, including improving and offering a venue for visiting performers, encouraging young aspiring artists, and expanding the music and theater departments of the schools. In our first production of the season, Blithe Spirit, and this Christmas production, we are blessed with music performed by Dr. Edward Morse, MVSU, and student participation from the local schools.

Dr. Ed Morse is an Associate Professor of Music at Mississippi Valley State University in Itta Bena, MS. At MVSU, Dr. Morse teaches applied trumpet, horn, trombone, tuba, and euphonium, as well as music education classes. He also directs the MVSU Brasswind Ensemble.

He currently performs Bass Trombone at The Jackson

Symphony. He was previously Visiting Assistant Professor of Music at Bethune-Cookman University and Adjunct Instructor of Low Brass at Daytona State College in Daytona Beach, FL.
