TO THE SUPERB JANICE MOOR

Greenwood Little Theatre is proud to dedicate this production of *Steel Magnolias* to the memory of Janice Moor.

Janice was a longtime GLT veteran and former past president of GLT who was also very active in other areas of the community, namely a former Executive Director of the Greenwood Chamber of Commerce. At GLT, Janice will long be remembered for her witty style and superb acting.

A native Kansan, Janice became a Greenwoodian in 1963, where she and husband Marion raised three children - all of whom shared the stage with her. She became involved with GLT in 1969's *Skin of Our Teeth*, and never looked back. Janice directed GLT's first production of *Cat on a Hot Tin Roof* in 1972, and enjoyed favorite roles in *Matchmaker*, *Oklahoma!* and *I Hate Hamlet*. Janice was cast in both the 1991 and 2004 productions of *Steel Magnolias* for GLT, playing the same role of "Clairee" in both productions. She loved that role, and always considered *Steel Magnolias* to be one of her favorite plays.

Janice moved to Nashville to be near her children in 2005 and passed away there in December 2021. Although she had been gone from Greenwood for many years, she certainly left her mark on this community and Greenwood Little Theatre. A genuine, warm and great lady with a wry sense of humor and a twinkle in her eye, Janice Moor will always hold a prominent spot in the Greenwood Little Theatre Hall of Fame.

PRODUCTION HISTORY

Steel Magnolias was originally produced off-Broadway in New York City on March 22, 1987. Two years later, it was adapted into an Academy Award nominated film, with an all-star cast. It is set entirely within a beauty parlor in Chinquapin Parish, Louisiana, where the women gather to laugh, gossip, cry and offer friendship and understanding. It covers nearly three years in the lives of six women, and each of the four scenes takes place many months after the last.

Greenwood Little Theatre first produced *Steel Magnolias* in March of 1991, directed by Celia Emmerich. It was produced a second time in May of 2004, directed by Theo White, Eddie Amelung and Helen Sanders. Connie Black, who plays "Truvy" in this production, played the role of "Shelby" in GLT's 1991 production.
